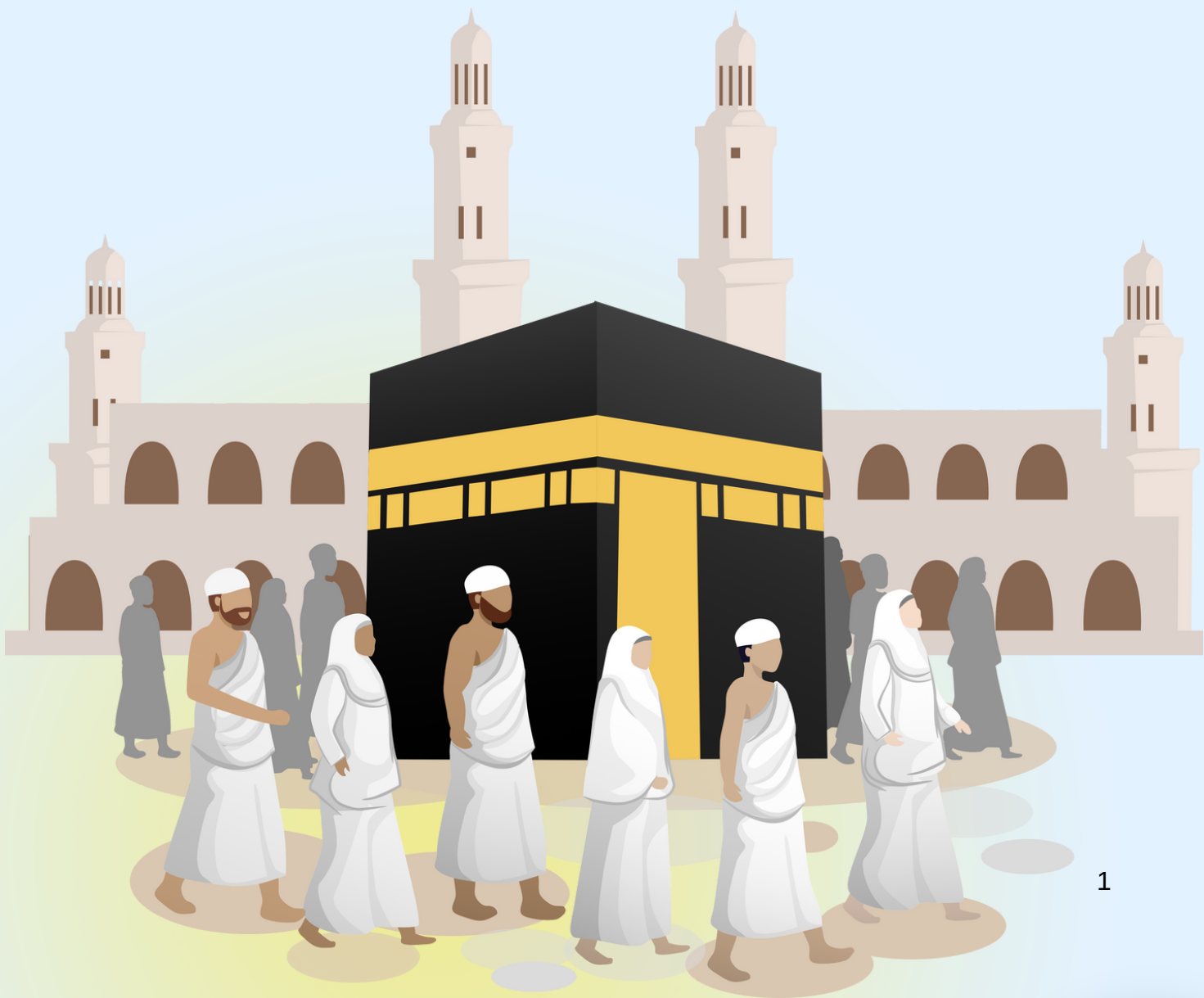


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25 Tips Hajj and Umrah

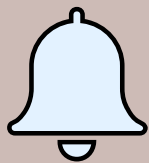

Purification and Spiritual Readiness



1. Purify your intention

Perform Hajj or Umrah solely to seek Allah's pleasure, not to be seen or admired.



Hadith

Actions are but by intentions, and every person will have only what he intended.

(Bukhari and Muslim)



2. Repent sincerely

Sincerely repent (tawbah) and ask Allah for forgiveness for all your sins, both minor and major.

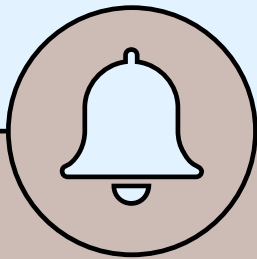


"O you who have believed, repent to Allah with sincere repentance." (Surah At-Tahrim, 66:8)



3. *Strengthen your tawhid*

Reflect on Allah's oneness and rely completely on Him in all that you do.

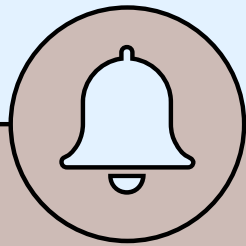

4. Forgive and free your heart from resentment

and ask forgiveness from those you
may have hurt.**

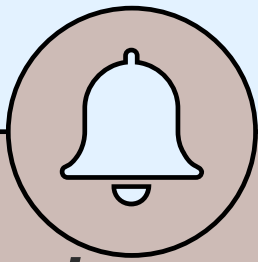

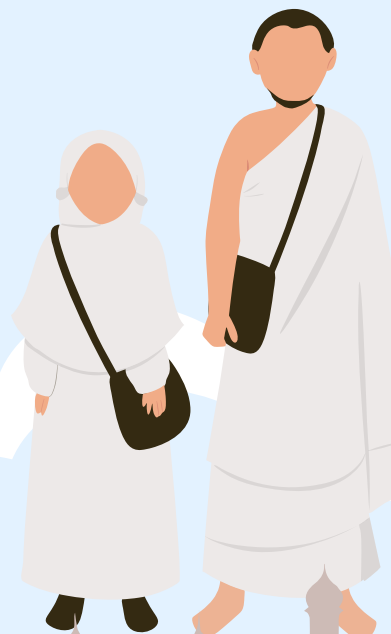


5- *Increase your acts of worship*

Before leaving, get used to praying in groups, reading more of the Quran, doing dhikr and giving charity.

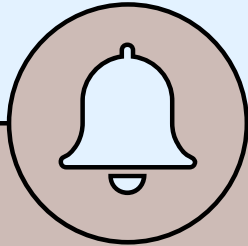


"And whoever honors the rites of Allah, indeed that is from the piety of the hearts." (Surah Al-Hajj, 22:32)



6. Learn to make sincere supplications (du'a)

Prepare personal supplications (du'as) for each stage of the journey, with your needs for this life and the hereafter.



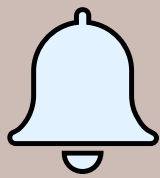

"The best supplication is the one made on the Day of Arafat, and the best words that I and the prophets before me have uttered are: 'La ilaha illa Allah, wahdahu la sharika lah, lahul mulk wa lahul hamd, wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir'." (Tirmidhi)

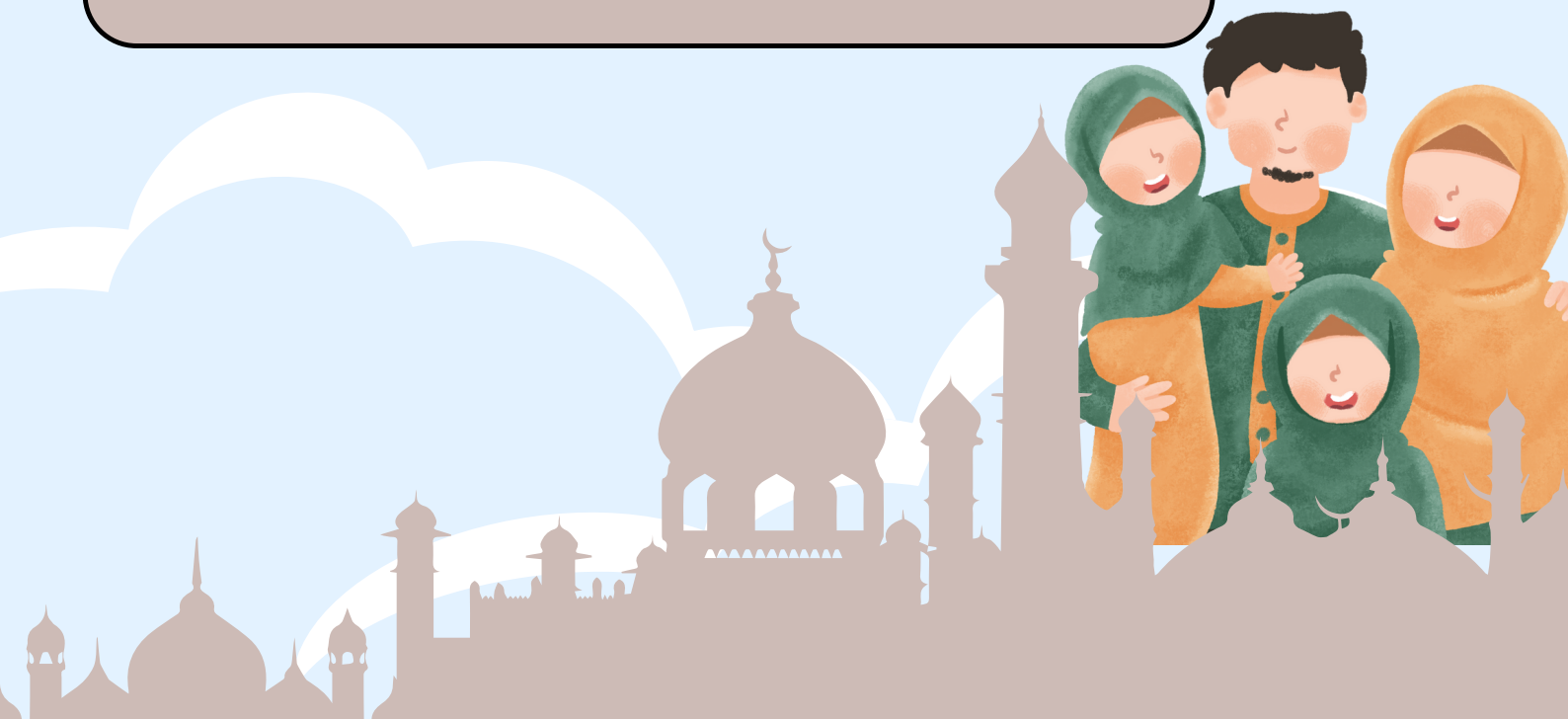


7- Remember the importance of the spiritual journey

Hajj is a rehearsal for our journey to the Hereafter; reflect deeply on your ultimate meeting with Allah.

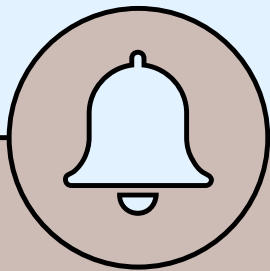


***"Say: 'Indeed, my prayer, my rites of sacrifice, my living and my dying are for Allah, Lord of the worlds.'"
(Surah Al-An'am, 6:162)***



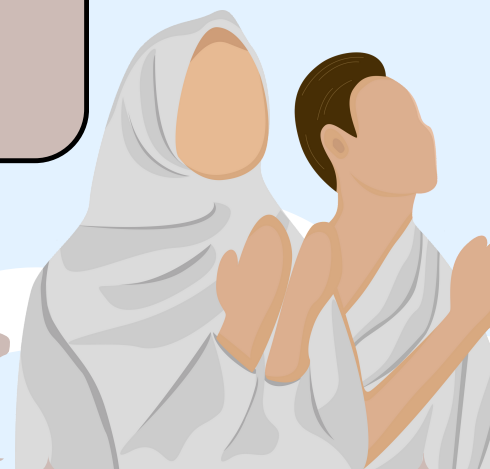
8- Read about the life of the Prophet ﷺ

This will help you better appreciate sacred places and their spiritual history.



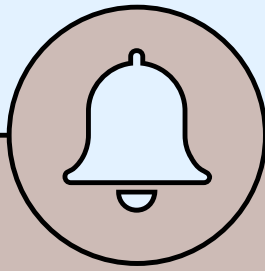

9. *Pray for constant sincerity*

Ask Allah to keep your intentions pure from beginning to end.

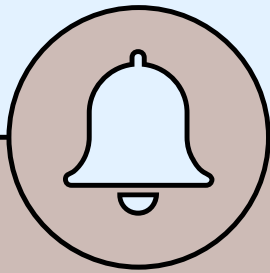


"Say: 'My acts of devotion, my sacrifices, my life and my death are for Allah, Lord of the worlds.'" (Surah Al-An'am, 6:162)



10- Consider your trip as a renewal

Think of it as an opportunity to return to a pure state, like a fresh spiritual beginning.

The performance of 'Umrah expiates the sins committed between it and the next one, and the reward for an accepted Hajj is nothing but Paradise. (Al-Bukhari and Muslim)

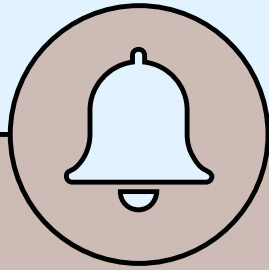

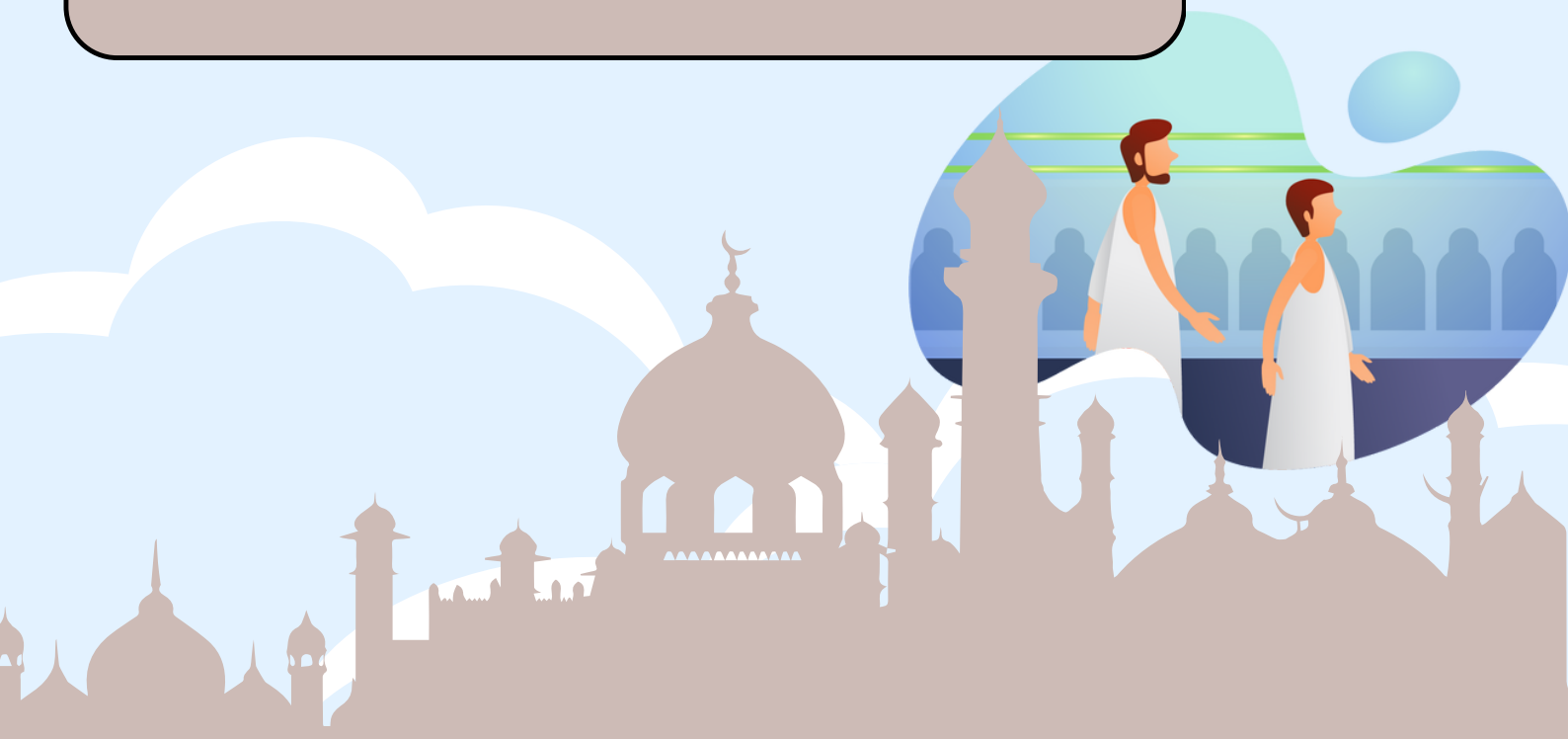


11- Remember Allah constantly

Every action, big or small, must be preceded and accompanied by dhikr.

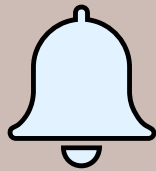


***“And worship your Lord until

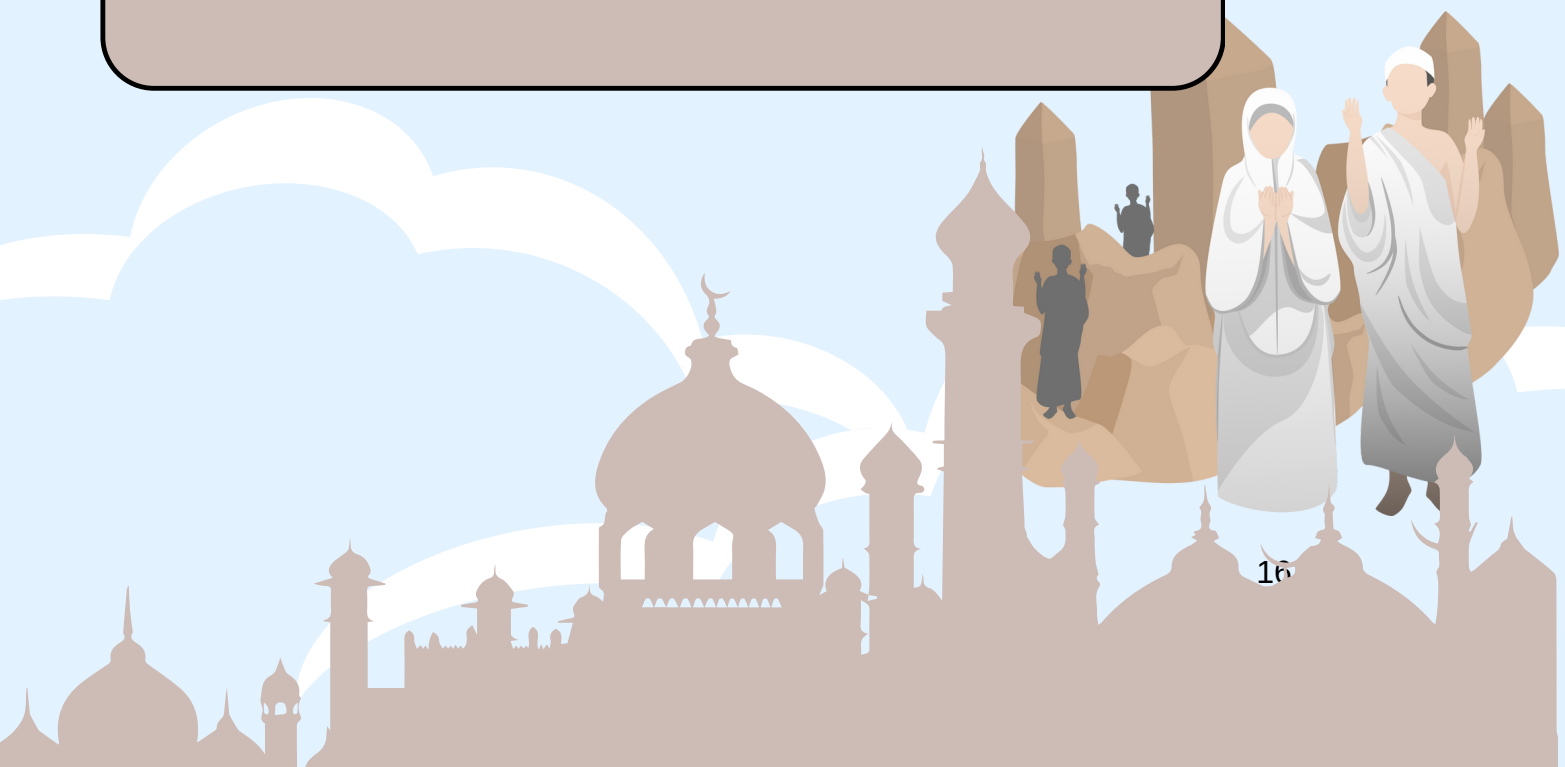


12- *Feel humility in the state of ihram*

The garments of ihram symbolize our equality before Allah and our detachment from worldly possessions.

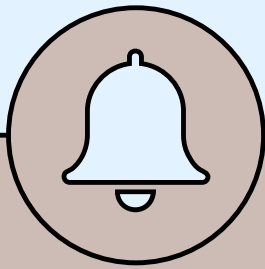


"Perform Hajj and Umrah for the sake of Allah." (Surah Al-Baqara, 2:196)



13- *Make each step an encounter with Allah*

Whether during the tawaf, the sa'i or at Arafat, feel His closeness and His greatness.

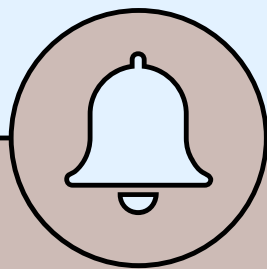
Do what you can of good deeds, for Allah does not tire as long as you do not tire.

14- *Remain in a state of gratitude*

Thank Allah for choosing you from among the millions of believers to visit His sacred House.

15- Supplicate abundantly

Each sacred place invites a deep spiritual connection, with Arafat being particularly special, where prayers are answered abundantly.

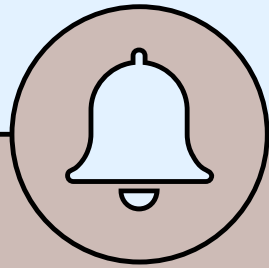

16. Reflect on your death

Visualize the tawaf as a metaphor for returning to Allah, as if you were circling around your ultimate goal.

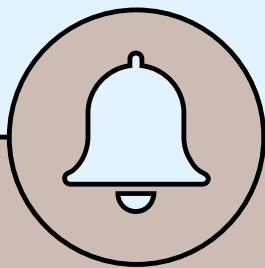

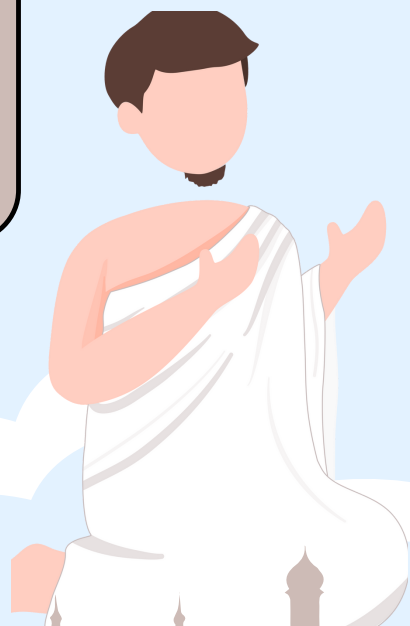


17. Embrace patience as a key virtue

The challenges of Umrah and Hajj are a test of your faith and your trust in Allah.

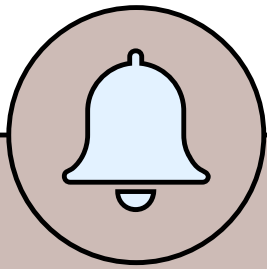

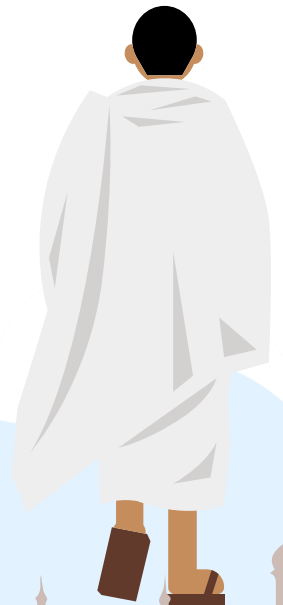
18. *Strive for the erasure of your sins*

Believe firmly in Allah's promise to purify you, if you perform Hajj or Umrah with sincerity.



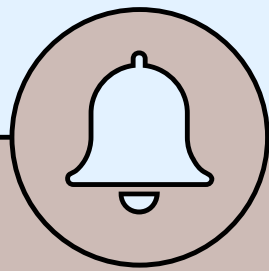

Above all, ask for Paradise, the goal we all strive for and our ultimate true purpose.

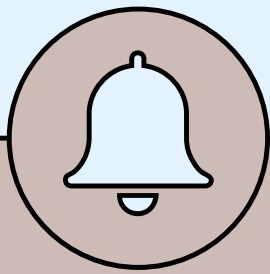

Help your brothers and sisters in Islam, even if it requires sacrifices. This is part of the teachings of Hajj and Umrah.



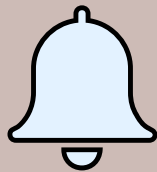

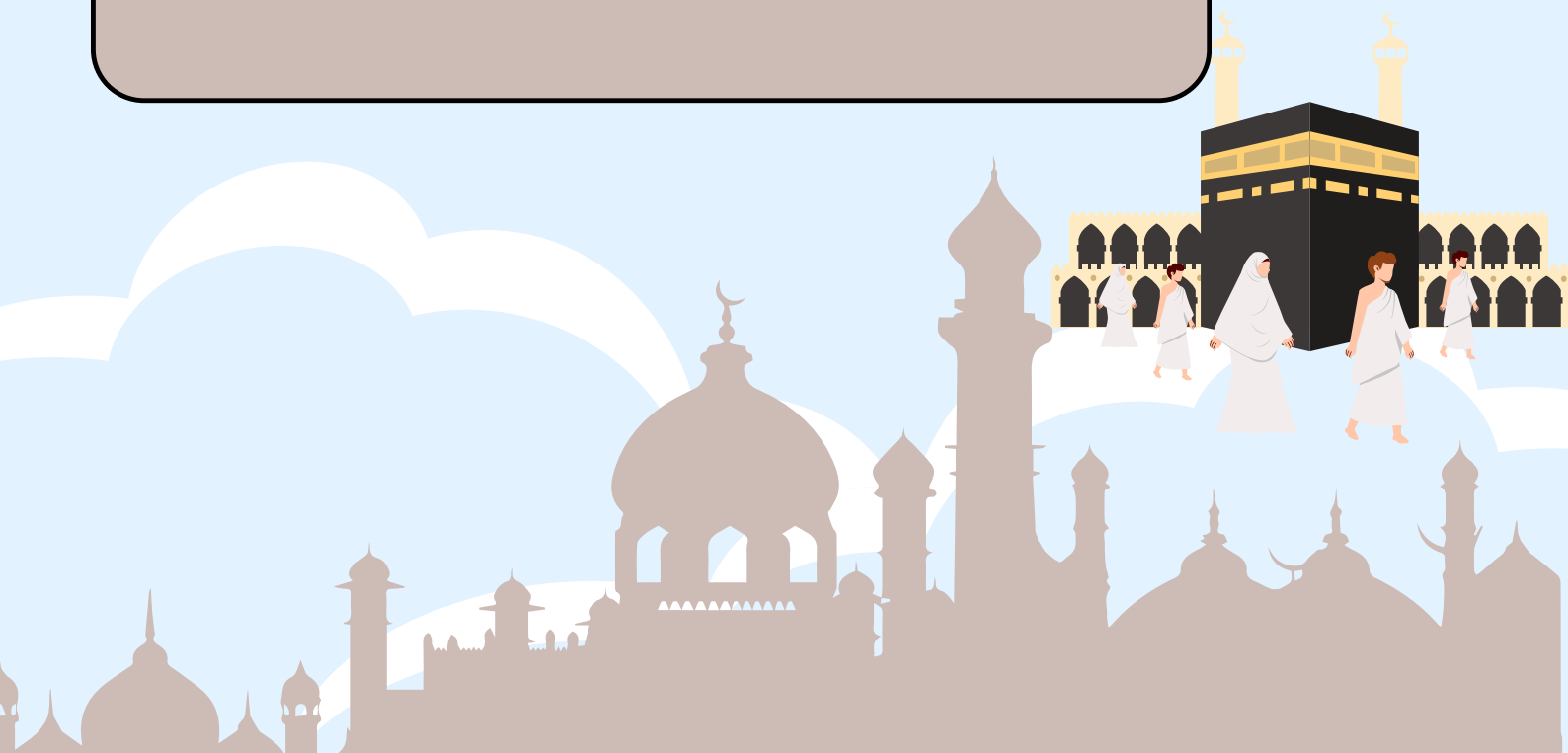


21- *Picture the Day of Judgment*

At Arafat, envision yourself before Allah, alone with your deeds, asking for His forgiveness and His mercy.

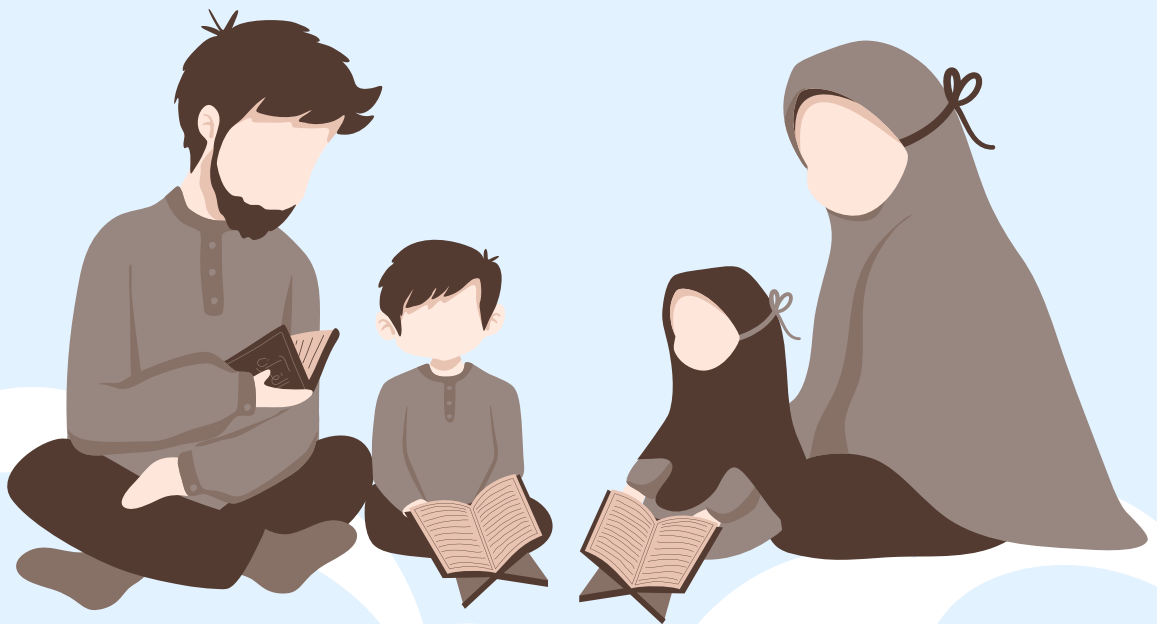

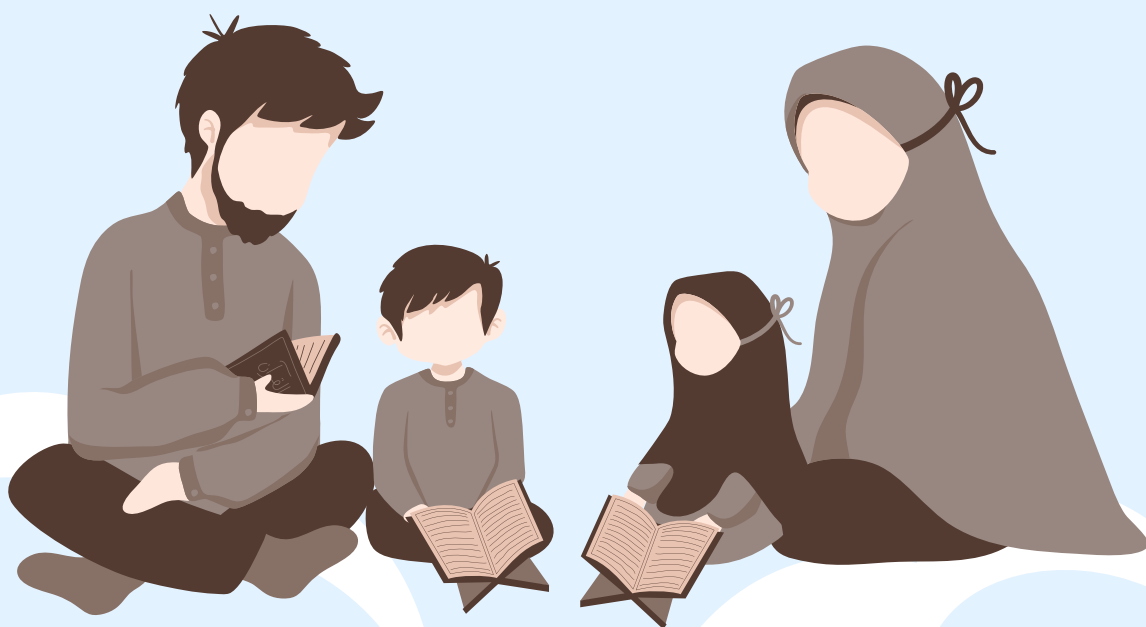

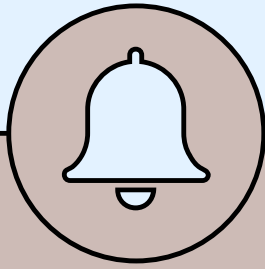

Return with the intention of applying the lessons you have gained to your life.

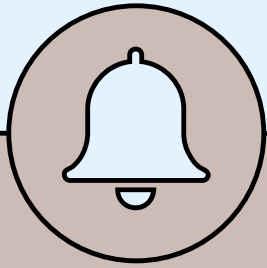


And whoever hopes to meet his Lord, let him do righteous deeds and not associate anyone in the worship of his Lord. (Surah Al-Kahf, 18:110)



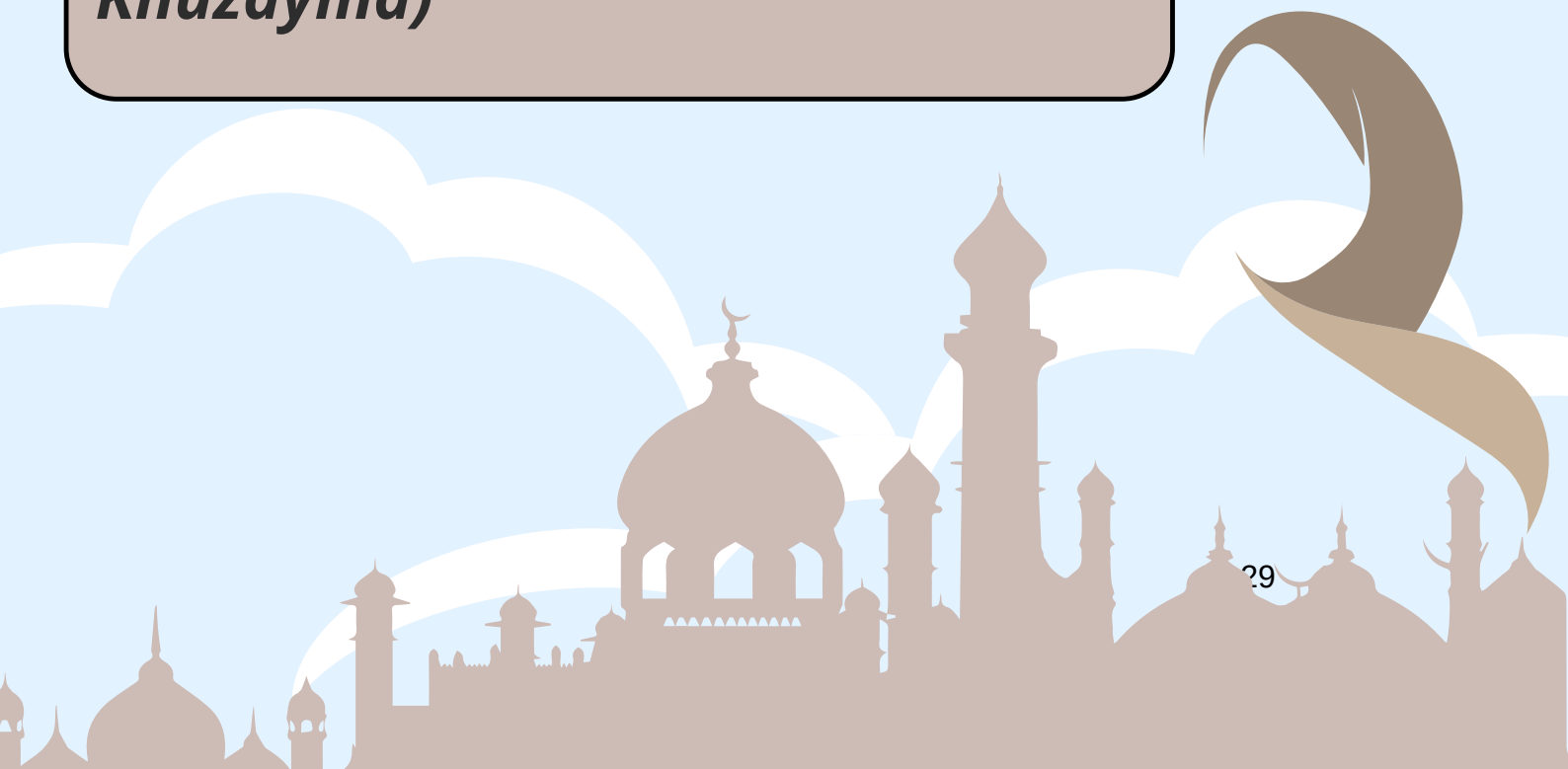
23- *Protect the purity you have gained*

Stay away from sins and worldly distractions to preserve the spiritual state you have regained.



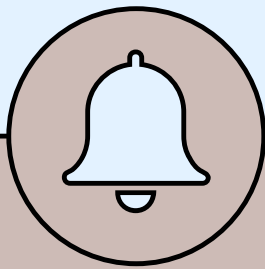

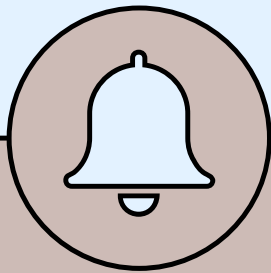


And be grateful to Allah if it is Him you worship. (Surah Al-Baqara, 2:172)
